### FROM OUR MINISTER . . . CELL: (252) 883-4495

As most of you know, I will begin a two-month sabbatical on July 1. I wanted to provide everyone in the congregation a copy of the letter that was sent to the General Board so that you can be fully informed about what I is happening. I look forward to returning in September.

Thank you for the opportunity to take my sabbatical during the months of July and August. As of July 1, I will have completed almost five and a half years of ministry at First Christian Church, Greenville, years that have been a blessing to my family and me. When I was called here in March of 2012, one of the agreements was that I would be given a two-month sabbatical after 5 years of service. While there is never a perfect time to do this, our Personnel Committee determined that the best time would be during the summer when there is less going on at church. During this time, Mike Goff will be leading worship on Sunday and preaching; and the elders will be responsible for pastoral care issues. I look forward to this two-month time of rest and renewal.

The following are my goals for my two months away:

- **Professional:** time to read in the area of church growth and evangelism (within the context of the mainline church); time to visit other congregations on Sunday and speak with other pastors to see what they are doing to attract and add new members.
- **Spiritual:** time to attend worship in various congregations without the responsibility of leadership; time to focus on my own spiritual life without the constant responsibility that comes from being spiritually responsible for others.
- **Personal:** time to spend with my spouse and family; time to travel visiting extended family or other places; time to do projects around the house; time to simply rest and renew, free from church responsibilities.

During the sabbatical, I will be released from all responsibilities in the church except in the event of a member's death. In that case, I would return to conduct the funeral.
